

# My First Intervals

Intervals are easy! To work out the interval (the gap) between two notes all you have to do is count them. Start on the first note and count up!

Use the piano to help you!

For example - the interval between C and E is a 3rd!



1 + 2 + 3 = 3rd!

Here are some songs that remind us of what each interval sounds like in an **octave scale** (8 notes!). Sing the first two notes of each song and hear the interval:

**2nd** - *Happy Birthday*

**3rd** - *Oh When the Saints*

**4th** - *We Wish You a Merry Christmas or Away in a Manger*

**5th** - *Twinkle Twinkle or Star Wars*

In case you are feeling extra clever here are a few more intervals for you to investigate...See how you get on!

**6th** - *Dashing Through the Snow*

**7th** - *Somewhere over the Rainbow* \***1st and 3rd** note this time!

**8th/8ve** - *Somewhere over the Rainbow* \***1st and 2nd** note again!
